With a network of Care Farms, we are engaging with men who have previously had an affinity with farms and other outdoor environments, through work, leisure activities or just a love of the countryside.



A short history of Countrymen UK

Inspiration

The model for Countrymen UK
was inspired by the success of the
Countrymen's club at the Future Roots
Care Farm in Dorset, which began in 2011,
with funding from the BIG Lottery Silver
Dreams Programme.

The Club was established after identifying a need for a service aimed at men who faced life changes as a result of rural isolation, health conditions and ageing.

Greater inclusion

The initial project identified individuals from rural communities who had perhaps worked in farming and other outdoor environments. However as the project developed, the Club evolved to include any man who has an interest in the countryside.

Dur aim is to offer person-centred opportunities that enable people to engage in activities and enhance their well being by stimulating both mind and body. We are now expanding our network of Countrymen UK Groups to other areas.
